- Hello for friends : 안녕 (annyeong)
- I love you : 사랑해요 (salanghaeyo)
- Hey ! : 야 ! (ya)
- Ouch ! (old persons) : 아이고 (aigo)
- Are you okay ? : 괜찮아 (gwaenchanha)
- Thank you : 감사합니다 (gamsahabnida)
- Good bye : 안녕히 계세요 (annyeonghi gyeseyo)
: 안녕히 가세요 (annyeonghi gaseyo)



ENDINGS

- For elders : the verb ending is 읍니다 (eubnida) with consonant and 습니다 (seubnida) with vowels
- For friends : 아요 (ayo) / 어요 (eoyo) / 해요 (haeyo) and more.
